1. Sing the song while performing macrobeats in bilateral motion on your lap.
2. Tell the students that you are going to perform macrobeats in other ways and that they should imitate your movement.
3. Sing the song again and perform macrobeats in a variety of ways.
4. Practice tapping the ground in front of you and then the ground in front of the student to your right on the next macrobeat.
5. Have students pass a stone around the circle, first without beat, and then to the macrobeats that you play on the hand drum.
6. At first chant "get" and "pass" to macrobeats to help them coordinate their movements with one another.
7. Sing the song and pass the stone or several stones to the song.
8. A student may sit in the center of the circle and play the hand drum to the macrobeats.
